# Through the years



### 1986 In the beginning

Coachman Caravans was founded in late 1986, and established a manufacturing plant in Hull, East Yorkshire. After deciding on a name that reflected the quality of the tourers the company wanted to produce, it began to create its first range.



### 1987 An instant success

Coachman Caravans was forging its path into the market, taking sales from the more established brands. Sales took off and, in 1988, the Coachman line-up expanded with the launch of a new luxury range, the VIP.



### **2011** Big design changes

Following years of expansion, investment and development, Coachman began the new decade by planning a major overhaul of its caravan designs. This process began in 2011, with big changes and improvements to the popular Amara range.



### 2014 The year of innovation

Coachman began working with Bostik, global leaders in adhesive solutions, to utilise the latest adhesives and swap out wood for advanced polyurethane. Caravans became stronger and lighter, whilst virtually eliminating the threat of water ingress.



2016 It's a family thing

A management buy-out, led by the company's MD Elliot Hibbs, ensured that Coachman remains 'in the family'. Elliot took over Coachman from his father, the late Jim Hibbs.



### 1994 A growing range

Coachman continued to develop and enhance the Genius, Mirage and VIP ranges throughout the mid 1990s, using innovative methods including computer aided design systems to improve caravan aesthetics and aerodynamic profiles.



### 2004 Renewed independence

Coachman extended its factory by 30,000 square feet as part of a £1.5-million development, having purchased three acres of land. It also focused on the quality and design of its tourers, developing a stringent new testing process.



### 2006 Award winning

A new wider shell for the Laser, Pastiche and VIP was introduced, plus new layouts and enhanced specification across the ranges. The caravan press reaction was overwhelmingly positive, and Coachman picked up a dozen industry awards in two years.



### 2020 A new look

Coachman was rebranded, with the company using a completely new logo and incorporating a new colour scheme. This striking new brand identity pushed the company forward into a new era of caravanning.



### **2021** A new era

Coachman Caravans was purchased by KABE AB, a Swedish company which specialises in the production of high-end caravans and motorhomes for the Scandinavian Market. Whilst the company is now under new ownership the company is still managed and run by the previous directors.



### 2024 Continued growth

Coachman continues to innovate and develop its vehicle ranges, despite a hard-fought and sporadic industry season. New models and upgrades stimulate customer demand and keep the company at the forefront of the industry.

# Alde's wet central heating system

Alde's wet central heating system has been meticulously planned and installed to ensure you always enjoy the optimum temperature throughout your caravan.

The radiant, hydronic central heating offers many benefits:

- It heats every part of the caravan creating a warm and inviting environment
- The glycol heating fluid circulates quietly around your caravan ensuring the least amount of disturbance
- It works off both gas and electric power sources which, can be combined when required
- Low 12V battery consumes a low amount of energy preserving your battery life
- Pipes and radiators are mounted discreetly behind furniture, optimising available storage

Coachman has a close and established relationship with Alde. Consultation happens at every stage of the design process to ensure the most efficient heat output, ventilation and installation possible.

Coachman caravans are subject to cold chamber testing. During this process your caravan is cold soaked down to -15°C for ten hours. After this the caravan must heat up to 20°C within four hours and running water must be operational to achieve a Grade 3 pass.

Our unique techniques ensure you receive one of the safest and most robust caravans on the market today. Every new model has to pass our fastidious and meticulous quality and safety checks.

It benefits from the following:

- **1.** 25mm sandwich construction roof for added strength and insulation
- 2. Screwless, body coloured, fully bonded awning rail to both sides
- **3.** 25mm aluminium sandwich sidewall construction with polystyrene insulation core
- **4.** 45mm sandwich construction floor with internal bracing for added strength

The Acadia range includes two, four and five-berth models designed to support keen beginners or seasoned adventurers.



The Lusso's new model boldly leads the range into the 2025 season.


